**FINAL JUDGEMENT AND CORRECTIVE  
ORDER**

21 THIS MATTER, having come before the Court for review of the disciplinary warning issued to  
22 Jack Williams on May 11, 2025, and the Court having reviewed the facts, staff communications,  
23 and moderation history, now issues the following Final Judgment and Corrective Order:

24 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 25 1. The warning issued to Jack Williams for "instigating drama" lacked citation of a specific  
26 rule and was issued without full review of relevant discussion.  
27 2. The warning came from a question posed in good faith regarding PSP conduct, which  
28 was respectful and appropriate.

3. Moderators directly tied to Pennsylvania State Police were involved in issuing and upholding the warning, presenting a conflict of interest.
4. Comparable conversations by other members did not result in warnings, indicating selective enforcement.
5. Internal staff chat records confirm the warning was rushed and not adequately justified.

## ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The warning issued to Jack Williams is declared invalid and retaliatory, and shall be immediately rescinded and removed from all records.
2. The following disciplinary action is imposed:
  1. Ryan Waters: 7-day suspension
  2. Parker Anderson: 5-day suspension; 20-day probation; all future warnings to be reviewed by a Senior Moderator
  3. Nelson Winters: 15-day strike for failure to intervene
3. The following policy changes are enacted:
  1. Moderators shall not adjudicate complaints involving departments to which they belong.
  2. All warnings must include a clear rule citation and supporting evidence.
  3. A formal appeals and moderation review process shall be created for all future staff actions.
