11		1. Ryan Waters: 7-day suspension
12		2. Parker Anderson: 5-day suspension; 20-day probation; all future warnings to be
13		reviewed by a Senior Moderator 3. Nelson Winters: 15-day strike for failure to intervene
14	3	The following policy changes are enacted:
15		Moderators shall not adjudicate complaints involving departments to which they
16		belong.
17		2. All warnings must include a clear rule citation and supporting evidence.
18		3. A formal appeals and moderation review process shall be created for all future
19		staff actions.
